



1st Annual Quilts of Christmas

Registration Rules & Information

- Entry dead line is Friday, October 14, 2011
- One quilt per entry/person
- Quilts must be constructed by the person or persons names on the entry form
- All entries must be quilted. A quilted entry consists of three layers, primarily fabric, held together by stitching, be no more than 80 x 80 full size and have a Christmas Theme
- Damaged, soiled, or unfinished quilts will not qualify for entry
- All quilts must have four inch hanging sleeves along the top of the quilt, on both ends and one in the middle top
- Quilts will not be returned to applicants they will be auctioned off with all proceeds benefiting the Walworth County Alliance for Children.
- No awards will be given, however, each accepted entry includes 2 tickets to the Charity Auction Dinner scheduled for December 29th at 6pm; additional are available for purchase
- Unacceptable entries include cheater cloth, pre-marked whole cloth kits, and printed fabric panels this will be at the discretion of Grand Geneva
- Shipping or Delivery costs are the responsibility of the entrant.
- Grand Geneva reserves the right to reject an entry at show time, if we find the rules have been violated and to publish photos of winning quilts and names of winners
- IMPORTANT: Entries must have your signature to be accepted. By signing and submitting your entry, you are giving permission for it to be photographed. Entrants hold harmless and waive all subrogation rights in connection with any loss of, or damage to, any quilt
